Metro Signalling Contractors with Old Roles

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform Signalling Contractors that from 1 Jul 2014 all Signalling Contractors with an old role will have these roles deactivated.

When did this change?

Mid 2013 the Signalling matrix was updated away from the older roles associated with the paper system. At the same time, whilst the older roles were turned off to prevent new people selecting them, these old roles remained active to allow signalling contractors to work.

When was I notified of the change?

In March 2014, all companies with Signalling Contractors registered with a RIW Card were contacted. As part of this email, companies were reminded that as part of your annual assessment to determine if your SoC is current and log books updated, that if you held an old role you should undertake an assessment against one of the new roles.

In addition, with the implementation of the Safety Leadership Training for Signalling Contractors, all companies were again reminded.

How do I know if I hold an old role?

Look at the current matrix available online and see if your current role is one of them. If your role is there, then you're fine, but if not you'll need to be assessed against a new role before you can work.

What if I need Safety Leadership Training for Signalling Contractors as part of my new Signalling Role?
