## Lineworker Role Update

The following information is provided to update Metro employees and contractors of the competency changes to the Metro Lineworker role.

### Why the change?

Since the role was released, Metro has received feedback from industry questioning the competency level required. As a result Metro completed a review of the role and confirmed the initial competency level set, which was based on Metro's own Lineworkers, was not required because the role a contracting Lineworker does is different than Metro's own Lineworkers.

### When will the role go live?

The role is live today 24 July 15.
