Track Vehicle Operator (TVO) Competency – Metro Employees

The purpose of this bulletin is to remind Metro Employees of the upcoming training dates for renewal of the TVO competency and the alignment to the nationally recognised Road Rail Plant operator role (previously called RRV).

What's the difference between the TVO old course and the new one?

As a result of the Office of the National Rail Safety Regulator's (ONRSR) audit into Road Rail Plant it was identified that rail safety workers operating these did not hold units of competence to operate the plant but did address MTM's Safeworking rules requirement. Whilst the old TVO course was compliant it did not map to any national units. The new TVO course now delivers 2 units, one to operate the plant and the other to map MTM's existing Safeworking rules to a national unit.

What do I need to do and by when?

You must complete the TVO renewal or full training before 1 Jul 16 or before your TVO qualification expires whichever is the sooner.

Who needs to attend?

Any employee wishing to travel and/or operate Road Rail Plant on MTM's network.

When are the course dates?

April 13th, 14th, 15th, 19th, 20th, 22nd, 27th, 28th, 29th

May 4th, 5th, 6th, 10th, 12th, 13th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 25th, 26th, 27th, 31st

June 2nd, 3rd, 8th, 9th, 10th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 22nd, 23rd, 24th

Training attendance is 1 day.
