1 July 2015 Compliance Reminder – New ‘MTM – Operator’ Role

The purpose of this bulletin is to remind all RIW APP users to check for the additional ‘MTM – Operator’ role from 1 July 2015.

Background

From September 2014, all RIW companies have been contacted regarding the new operator roles, what they mean and the **1 July 2015** compliance date.

So what does this mean?

From **1 July 2015**, all contractors entering MTM’s Rail Corridor **MUST** have the ‘MTM – Operator’ role on their RIW Card along with their other MTM or National roles. Just holding an MTM or National role does not mean you can work for Metro, you **MUST** also hold the ‘MTM Operator’ role.

Whilst these Operator roles were created to support the release of the National Roles in 2014, MTM contractors with MTM roles must also hold the ‘MTM – Operator’ role.

Below are some role examples.

	<i>Pre 30 June 15 Compliance</i>	<i>Post 1 July 2015 Compliance</i>	<i>Comments</i>
Example 1	MTM – Handsignaller Bobcat – National	MTM – Handsignaller Bobcat – National MTM – Operator	This contractor can work as a Handsignaller and operate a Bobcat for MTM
Example 2	Plumber – National	Plumber – National MTM – Operator VLine – Operator	This contractor can work as a Plumber for both VLine and MTM.
Example 3	VLine – Signal Designer VLine – Around The Track Person	VLine – Signal Designer VLine – Around The Track Person MTM – Operator	This contractor can only work for VLine. The ‘MTM – Operator’ role MUST be accompanied by an MTM or National Role.

All personnel found without an ‘MTM – Operator’ role will be removed from site.
