Night Train

All lines will operate except Stony Point and Flemington Racecourse.



- > After 1am, all trains will run direct to and from Flinders Street.
- > City Loop stations will continue to close shortly after midnight as they do now, and Southern Cross Train Station will close shortly after 1am.
- > Premium stations will be staffed all night.



Night Tram

Night Trams will operate on routes:



- > The Free Tram Zone will continue to apply to all night travel.
- > PTV and tramTRACKER apps will provide real-time information through the night.



Night Bus

Night Buses will operate to and from the CBD and suburban train stations.

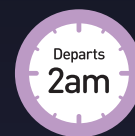


- > Most bus routes from the city will run every 30 minutes, while buses departing from suburban stations will run hourly to align with train timetables.
- > Customers are encouraged to check timetables (once available) and use the journey planner to plan their travel.



Night Coach

Late night V/Line coaches will travel from Southern Cross Station coach terminal to Geelong, Ballarat, Bendigo, and Traralgon around 2am on Friday and Saturday nights.



- > Coaches will stop at any station along the rail corridor on request.
- > Community feedback will be a key part of the evaluation of the trial, to help inform whether timetables should be expanded in the future.
