When will the training sessions be held?

There will be another two Metro Signal Safety Leadership training classes scheduled for 2018; these classes will be held on the:

Will there be any off-site, overseas or interstate training sessions?

What happens if I don't attend?

If you don't complete Signal Safety Leadership training your Signalling role will:

- A.** Drop back to 'working towards' even if you have a current extension uploaded into the Onsite system.
- B.** If you are trying to obtain the signalling work role from the above list on page 1 you will not be able to until you complete the Signal Safety Leadership training.

Where will the training sessions be held?
