# **Carrum Station car park closure**

During the full closure of Carrum Station car park, alternative passenger parking has been provided at Bonbeach Foreshore (off Williams Grove), Chelsea Library and Seaford North Reserve.

Please note that alternative passenger parking locations may change during the project and passengers will be advised ahead of time.

Passengers requiring accessible parking are advised to use Chelsea and Seaford stations.

## **Pedestrian detours**

Pedestrian detours will be in effect around the Carrum Station precinct throughout the project.

Wayfinding signage and traffic management will be in place to assist people moving around the area.

### Pedestrian shuttle bus

The Station Street pedestrian level crossing and Carrum Station underpass will close from 1:15am Saturday 6 July 2019.

There will be no access across the rail line from 1:15am Saturday 6 July until 4am Monday 29 July 2019. Detours will be via the Karrum Karrum bridge or Eel Race Road.

During this time, a pedestrian shuttle bus will operate. Please see map overleaf for pedestrian shuttle bus stop locations.

A new pedestrian crossing between Karrum Karrum Bridge and the old Station Street level crossing will open from 4am Monday 29 July 2019.

Carrum Station will close from 1:15am Saturday 6 July 2019 to allow for the removal of the existing station building and train storage area, and build Carrum's new rail bridge and station. Trains will run express through Carrum until the new modern Carrum Station opens in early 2020.

# **Ticketing**

While the station is closed, station facilities and myki readers will not be available.

Passengers should touch on and off at Bonbeach and Seaford stations. New myki card purchases or myki top ups can be made at Bonbeach or Seaford stations, or at your nearest myki retail outlet.
