## Your new Reservoir Station is coming – temporary arrangements

The new elevated platforms at Reservoir Station will be open from first service, Monday 16 December when trains resume on the Mernda line.

While the station will be safe and operational, there will be temporary arrangements in place as work continues around the station precinct until mid-2020.

When trains stop at Reservoir Station on Monday 16 December there will be no lift access to the elevated platform. Access will be via temporary stairs at the northern end of the platform.

# Buses replace trains on the Mernda line

## Plan ahead to avoid long delays

From 7.30pm Tuesday 3 December to last train Sunday 15 December, buses replace trains on sections of the Mernda line.

During this time, the Level Crossing Removal Project will complete the rail bridge over High Street and Reservoir Station. The old station platforms will be demolished, and new track and overhead wires will be installed. Trains will run on the new bridge from first service Monday 16 December.

**Note**, works may also be carried out on the Mernda line by other projects, unplanned works or regular maintenance renewal programs.

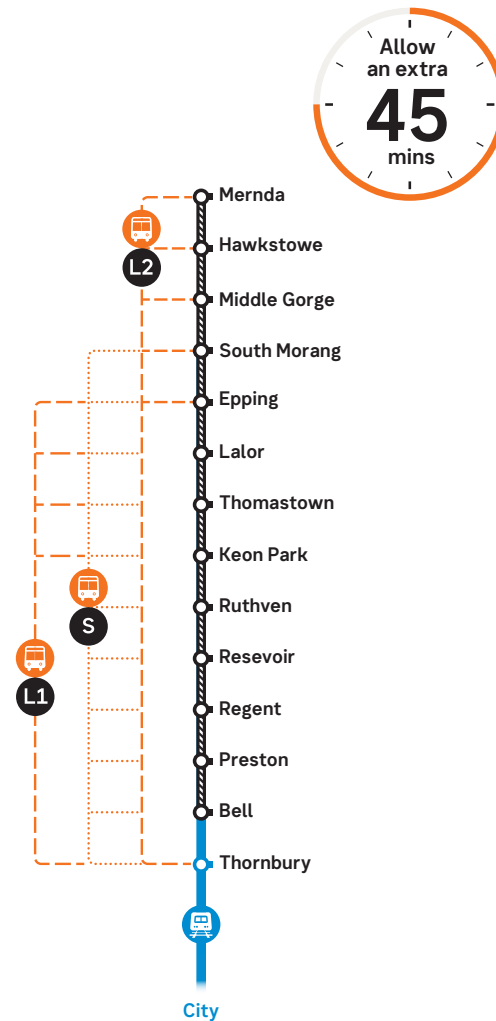
## Choosing your most direct replacement bus

### Thornbury to Mernda

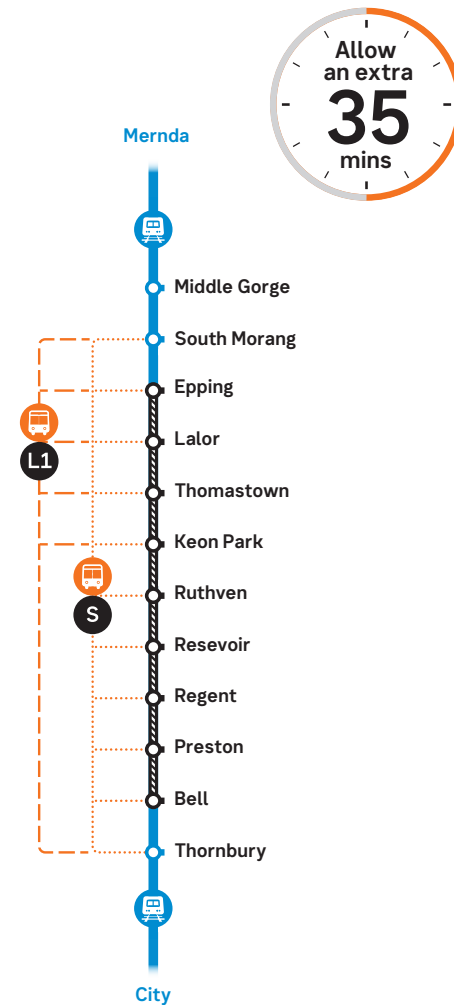
7.30pm Tuesday 3 December to last train Thursday 12 December \*



\*Note, buses replace trains between Parliament and Mernda from 7.30pm to last train each night, Tuesday 3 December to Wednesday 4 December

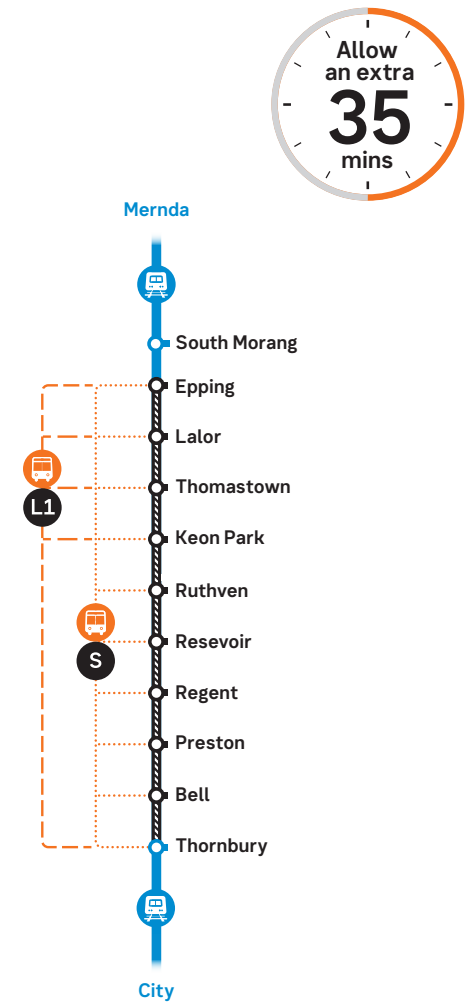
### Thornbury to South Morang
