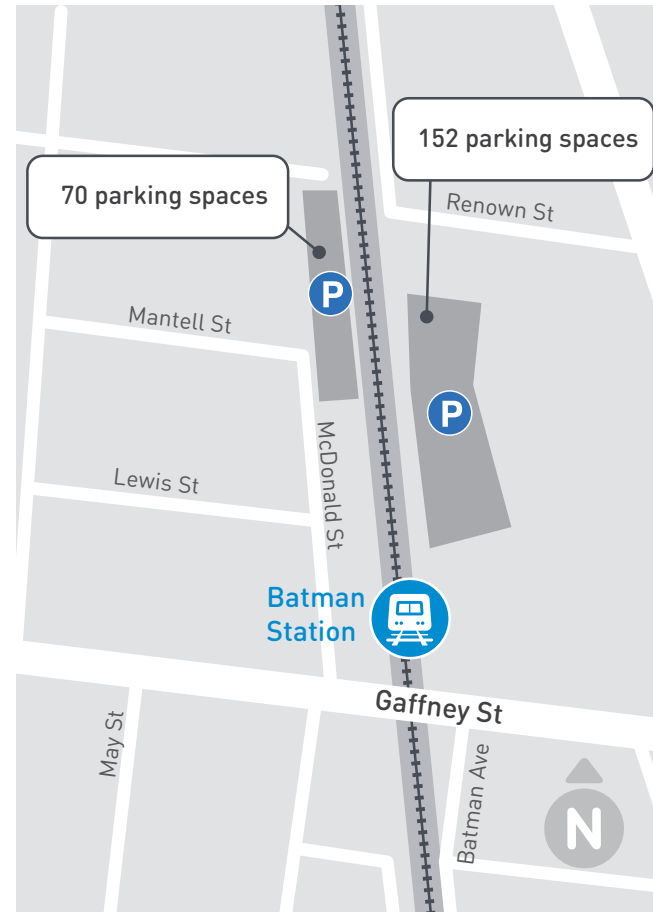

Alternative car parking

During the closure of the asphalted car park at Moreland Station, alternative passenger parking will be provided at Batman Station.

The car park east of the rail line (access via Gaffney Street) will open on **Monday 3 February**.

The car park west of the rail line (access via McDonald and Mantell streets) will open on **Monday 17 February**.



Ticketing

The myki customer vending machines and touch-on facilities will stay open during construction.

Passengers need to touch on and off as they would when travelling at any other time.

Other disruptions

Trains will continue to operate from the station platforms, except during planned or unplanned disruptions.

Changes to Moreland Station

Works are underway to remove the level crossings at Bell Street, Munro Street, and Reynard Street in Coburg, and Moreland Road in Brunswick.

As we prepare to raise the rail line and build the new Moreland Station, works will take place around the station precinct to establish the project site.

Access around the station will change for the duration of the project to create safe working zones and allow for construction activities.

Car park closures

The gravel CArE Park south of Moreland Road will close on **Monday 13 January**, and the asphalted car park next to the station will close on **Monday 3 February**.

Alternative passenger parking will be provided at Batman Station. See map of alternative parking locations overleaf.

Passengers requiring accessible parking are advised to use the alternative parking facilities at Batman Station or other neighbouring stations along the Upfield line.

Pedestrian and cyclist detours

Access through the reserve to the east of the station will change on **Monday 13 January**, and the pedestrian overpass will close on **Thursday 6 February**.

The Upfield Bike Path between O’Hea Street, Coburg and Albion Street, Brunswick will close from **Thursday 6 February**.

The project, in consultation with key stakeholders, has developed local detour routes using existing “shimmy” routes to the east and west of the existing Upfield Bike Path.

Wayfinding signage and traffic management will be in place to assist people moving around the area.

Bus stop closure

The Moreland Station/Moreland Road bus stop servicing route 510 (Essendon to Ivanhoe) travelling to Ivanhoe will close on **Thursday 6 February**.

Alternative travel options include walking 200 metres to the route 510 bus stop at Sydney Road (east of the rail line), or 250 metres to the route 510 bus stop outside John Fawkner Private Hospital (west of the rail line).

Bike hoop removal

The bike hoops at Moreland Station will be removed on **Monday 13 January**. Bike hoops are available at nearby Anstey Station.

The new station will feature improved bicycle facilities including a secure bicycle cage and bicycle hoops located undercover.
